Additional information for sewing class

Come spend a few days learning how to sew using a sewing machine. Students will learn the parts of the machine, how to thread and wind a bobbin, and follow a pattern guide sheet while making a simple colorful pillowcase they will make and take home. Students will select an hour time slot for the dates listed above when registering (9:00-10:00, 10:30-11:30, 1:00-2:00 or 2:30-3:30) (only 2 students per time slot). They will come each day during that timeframe. If a student does not finish their project during this timeframe, agent will schedule additional dates. Each student will need to bring the following to class: fabrics needed, thread, a pin cushion, straight pins, and a seam ripper. Pattern and sewing machines will be provided. If you have a **working** machine, I encourage students to bring. I prefer they learn on the machine they will be using for future sewing projects.

Fabric needed for project: (Cotton or Cotton Blends 44/45 inch width)

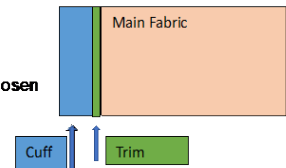
7/8 yard of main fabric

3/8 yard of cuff fabric

1/8 yard of trim fabric

Other notions needed for project:

Thread that will go with all three fabrics chosen
